

UNIFORM POLICY

Glenview State School is a full uniform school with a School Dress Code. The P&C has designed and approved the Uniform and manages a School Uniform Shop. Wearing School Uniform with pride, is an important element in helping a child to develop their sense of identity and a sense of belonging which are essential elements in developing resiliency. Similarly, the sports shirts of the relevant group (House) can be worn on PE days and the Senior (Yr 6) shirts assist in further refining the identity and belonging focus.

Uniforms are available from the Uniform Shop (located in the Hall). Online orders can be completed via the Flexischools app and these will be delivered to the student's classroom.

Dress Code

Personal Appearance: Please note. Children should be generally neat, tidy and well-groomed at all times.

School Uniform is to be worn on all excursions and at all school events unless specific permission is obtained for alternative attire.

Shoulder length hair (or longer) is to be plaited, braided or tied back.

Students may have colouring of a natural tone where the nature of the colouring is discrete, large patches of colours and stripes are not permitted.

Hairstyles such as mohawks, rats tails, undercuts and visible patterns are not permitted.

No make-up or nail polish is to be worn.

Jewellery: Watch. Earrings – small plain sleeper or stud. Medical alert bracelet or necklace. Items of significant religious belief as negotiated with administration.
