

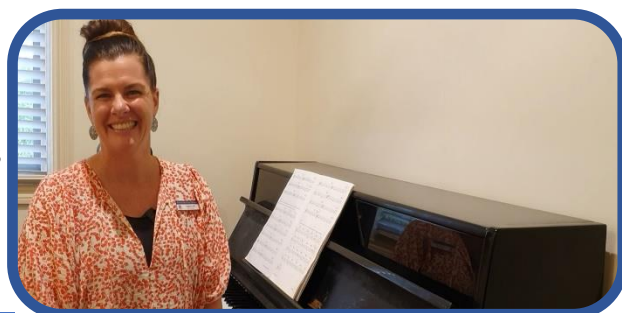
Introducing Glenview State School's Music Teachers for 2021
