A MESSAGE FROM MR LLOYD



Dear Parent and Carers

As the cooler weather approaches, I'd like to reinforce the message that we are providing to our students regarding correct uniform at the school. The uniform policy which is endorsed by the P&C is an important element of our school and I appreciate seeing our students wearing the uniform with pride.

We have school jumpers for sale and these are to be worn through the cooler months. Please ensure that the jumpers are labelled with your child's name, as winter days often start cool, but as the day warms, students remove the jumper and sometimes neglect to bring them home. We are always happy to assist in ensuring the jumper gets back to students, as long as we can identify the owner.

I am also continuing to remind students regarding the wearing of black shoes and white socks as these are also the required uniform for our school.

As you would understand, my priority at school is a focus on student learning and student behaviour, however I do also appreciate your assistance in maintaining pride in our school through the wearing of the correct uniform. Thank you!

It has been wonderful this term to be finally free of construction in the school and to have much greater freedom of movement for students and adults alike. Construction began late in 2022 and whilst it was a long process, there have been many positive changes to the school and our students will benefit from these for many years.

We now have a new Admin block and a refurbished area to use as a library, but additionally we were also provided with:

- Plumbing upgrade;
- Electrical upgrade;
- Wifi and Network improvement with new switches and fibre in every block; and
- New telephone systems

The new playground area and the relocated shade structure at the front of the school also contribute to improving the operation of the school, and giving greater options for our students.

A MESSAGE FROM MR LLOYD

Thank you all for your patience during this period – the wait has been worth it!

I'd also like to thank you for your patience during construction regarding parking and pick-up. It is always very busy at the end of the school day, but we no longer have contractors parking at the school and now have some limited parking inside the school for staff. This has freed up some car spaces, though I know it remains difficult in the afternoons. We have received a few complaints from nearby dwellings, asking that cars do not park in their driveways. I would also ask that adults remain their vehicles in the pick-up area next to Anderson Oval. I am there most days and I appreciate the need to allow free flow of traffic so we can minimise congestion on Glenview Road. As we now have initiated a concept plan for a larger staff carpark, I remain hopeful that this may be actioned in the not too distant future.

Finally, I'm looking forward once again to our annual book fair. This year we will be able to hold the book fair in our new library space (the old Admin Block) and we look forward to welcoming all of you there in week 5 (beginning May 13)!

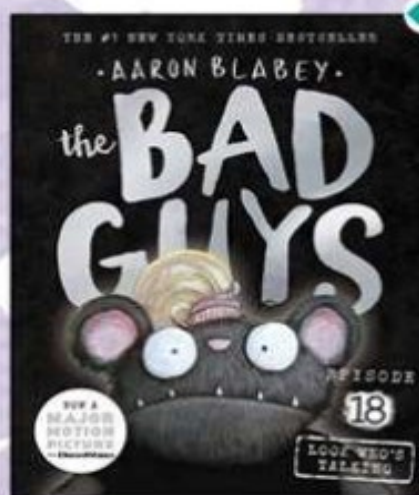
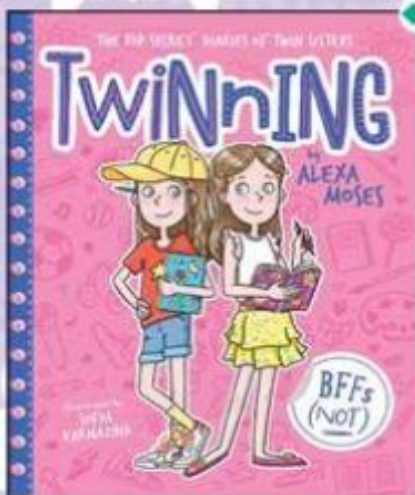
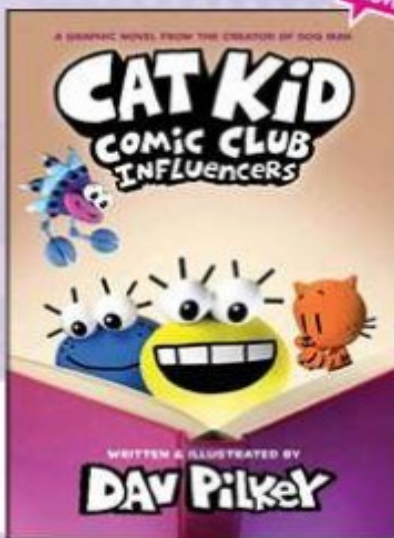
